The schedule for the PGY2 – PGY4 is based on the “x + y” model. Residents are on rotations during the “x” weeks such as inpatient teams, consultation service, outpatient clinics, or electives followed by the “y” week which consists of COC clinics, subspecialty clinics, and administration time.

Residents are on a night float rotation for overnight call. Night float is 6 nights in a row, occurring every ~ 8 weeks for PGY2 residents and every ~ 14 – 16 weeks for PGY3 and PGY4 residents.
